

SPS Extracurricular Eligibility Policy

Policy:

Students will be evaluated weekly by teachers as to conduct, effort and academic performance in their core content classes. Student conduct and effort, deemed as poor by their teacher(s), will be considered ineligible for extracurricular participation. Academic performance which is 69% or below will be considered ineligible, unless otherwise waived by the principal.

Procedures:

Each teacher in grades 5-8 will receive a roster of students who are participating in all activities throughout the school year.

Students will always have the opportunity to correct and improve their situation if they choose to make the effort. If this is the case, no student shall be removed from an activity permanently due to academic concerns.

Major behavior offenses (vandalism, stealing, other un-Christian behaviors) will affect eligibility in a manner to be determined by the school administrator and may result in permanent student removal from SPS extracurricular activities.

Students begin each new activity with no probationary effect from the previous activity unless deemed necessary by the school administrator.

Eligibility is intended to be used as an aid in helping students reach their fullest potential academically, athletically, and spiritually.

Students will be allowed to participate based on three levels of eligibility:

First Offense:

- The first warning does not affect the student's eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.
- Parents, student and athletic director (AD notifies coach), or extracurricular supervisor are notified each Friday morning.
- **Parents are expected to contact teachers to address concerns.**
- **The student is expected to take corrective action to improve conduct, effort or grades as needed.**

Second Offense:

- The student may not participate the week after their second offense
- Students are expected to take part in practices in an effort to honor their commitment and their responsibilities to others. **Students are expected to attend activities as a spectator but may not participate.**

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- Parents, student and athletic director (AD notifies coach), or extracurricular supervisor are notified each Friday morning.
- **Parents are expected to contact teachers to address concerns.**
- **The student is expected to take corrective action to improve conduct, effort or grades as needed.**

Third Offense:

- The student may not participate until grades and/or behavior and effort have improved to acceptable levels.
- Students are expected to take part in practices in an effort to honor their commitment and their responsibilities to others. **Students are expected to attend activities as a spectator but may not participate.**
- **Parents must notify teachers and coach if their child quits the extracurricular activity.**
- Parents, student and athletic director (AD notifies coach), or extracurricular supervisor are notified each Friday morning.
- **Parents are expected to contact teachers to address concerns.**
- **The student is expected to take corrective action to improve conduct, effort or grades as needed.**
