

Middle School Supply List 2019-2020

Wanting to encourage organizational skills and to ease the transition between grade levels, the upper elementary and middle school teachers will be using the same binder and planner system. In order to properly implement this system, please follow these guidelines when purchasing supplies for the upcoming school year:

The Organizational Binder*

One binder: 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch binder
[Color coded plastic folders](#)-(2 pocket/3 hole punched) *example linked*

- Blue--Science
- Green--ELA
- Red--Math
- Yellow--Social Studies
- Purple--Religion
- 2 additional folders, your choice (fun style)

1 single subject spiral notebook in red for Math

Loose Leaf Paper (please keep stocked)

**Binders will also include a Student Planner provided by the school. The complete binder will be brought to every class. Students should it take home every night.*

Pencil box/bag with the following supplies (please keep stocked):

[Personal supplies needed for every class...be sure your name is on your things]

- 1 glue stick
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 ruler
- 1 box of colored pencils
- pencils and erasers
- 1 hand-held sharpener

- 1 highlighter pen
- 1 red pen
- 2 black Sharpie markers...1 fine and 1 ultra fine

Headphones/Earbuds for use with chromebooks

Some kind of protective case for chromebooks is strongly recommended.

Shared supplies for homeroom [to be left in the classroom]:

- 4 boxes of tissues
- 2 canisters of Lysol wipes
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Hand sanitizer
- Glue sticks (multi-pack)
- Set of 4 dry erase markers-various colors
- One pack of loose leaf paper-for classroom

Additional Supplies by Subject (kept in the classroom)

Science:

- 1 composition book-graph paper style (*may need an additional one later in year*)

ELA:

- 1 composition notebook
- 2 single subject spiral notebooks--green

Math:

- Scientific Calculator
- 1 (additional) single subject spiral notebook--red

Religion:

- 1 composition notebook
